
Ministerial Order - (Potential) Redeployment of Teachers

Dear Member,

Some of you may have heard that a Ministerial Order was signed this morning by Health Minister McCann. It is attached to this email. This order states that all employees (teachers, support staff, professionals) of school boards and cégeps can be redeployed to work in the Health Sector, with the exception of those whose services are deemed essential to teaching:

« à l'exception du personnel dont une prestation de travail est jugée essentielle par le ministre de l'Éducation et de l'Enseignement supérieur pour le maintien des services [...] d'enseignement »

According to the information that we have received from FNEEQ, the Deputy Education Minister, Eric Bergeron, has stated in his meeting with union representatives, that the purpose of Ministerial Order is to be able to redeploy those teachers and staff who work in health-related disciplines. This is not, however, how the Ministerial Order is worded.

FNEEQ representatives have requested a copy of the "Administrative Guide for applying the ministerial order" that is apparently in existence. Locally, the DTU Executive is meeting with Dawson directors tomorrow to discuss the ministerial order.

As soon as we have any additional information we will communicate with you.
